NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS SATURDAY, NOV. 29th 7 AM – NOON

Saturday, November 29th is the 28th Anniversary of the Santa Claus Parade.

Once again, we ask you to observe the “NO PARKING” restrictions that will be in place from 7AM to 12 NOON.

To allow for the line-up of the Parade and Parade Route, the restrictions include:

St. Paul St. between 2nd Ave & 4th Ave.
Battle St. between 2nd Ave & 4th Ave.
Nicola St between 2nd Ave & 4th Ave.
Victoria St. between 2nd Ave & 7th Ave
2nd Ave from St. Paul to Victoria St.
3rd Ave from Columbia to Lansdowne St.

There will be traffic restrictions on Seymour St. between 1st Ave and 3rd Ave, 3rd Ave between Columbia and Lansdowne St.; from 2nd to 7th Avenues between Seymour and Lansdowne. The parade will disperse in the 600 block Victoria. We suggest you use Lorne St., Columbia St. and/or 1st Ave to detour around the congestion. If you need to access your parking spot in this area please use 4th Ave and the back alleys.

IMPORTANT BUS LOOP INFORMATION:

The Lansdowne Village Mall Transit transfer station will be temporarily relocated to St. Paul St between 5th and 6th Avenues. This station will be in effect for duration of parade. Approx 10:15am to 1:30pm. No parking on St. Paul St. between 5TH & 6TH Avenue.
